Howdy All,

January came in cold and wet, but we managed to burn some powder anyway. I got a chance to shoot Classic Cowboy and had a blast. I've had that hammer shotgun almost 3 years and this was its first match. I'm gonna shoot CC again soon.

We had a small work party Saturday to get some things fixed on the range and finished setting up for the coming match. We think the club is ready to open Cody-Dixon up at all regular matches through the year. The times are about the same with 5 long range rifle over 10 stage rifle. Single shots are slower, but we are not seeing them used much. This coming match on Saturday will start the category.

The swinging target is ready and is on the Stagecoach stage, which we will be shooting this Saturday. It will be shot with pistol 5 rounds, about 8 steps out from the line.

We made adjustments to the wooden shotgun targets so that the chain will not hang up. We added a ledge on the Caboose platform for staging long guns, so that we don't have to use the corner anymore. We also made plans for grading in the Blazing Saddles Stage between the Graveyard and the Old Town area. The frame work, railing and carriage are coming to life in my driveway and I should have it all ready to transport in sections in about 2 weeks if the weather holds up.

The Officers would like to edit the By-Laws next month, so please take a look at them, it's a small edit covering to allow the Officers asking someone to leave the range if needed and also to allow the President to spend up to \$500 for club needs, such as target repairs needs, chuck wagon supplies, etc. This spending would be reported to the officers, only that the President could make the decision before reporting.

Elections need to be in May, as Comancheria Days is in April. Any one wishing to step up and run for Office can let us know and we will put it in the coming newsletters and announce at the shooters meetings. I will re run for President this year.

Thanks to Dirty Dog Dale for making some great tasting soup for January. Also thanks to all the folks that are helping work Comancheria Days 07, we have had many requests to help out this year.
