I found a local shop with a plasma cutter that will cut our steel at \$40 per hour, if he cuts a large square into 4 targets it's only \$10. He has 1 sheet and I will bring in 2 more, then I can finish the targets. The bases and stands are done and painted. We will start with 16 targets, 8 to a side. After looking at space, might make 4 more. I estimate the project costs with the new welder, saw and materials to be around \$1500. Now the club can do its own welding at the range or at a project location.

We need a clean up work party soon, Becky has made requests. There is a bunch of old wooden reels down past the grave yard; we will have to burn them. They are in bad shape and I don't want to haul them to the pit. The pile of wood by the Chuck Wagon needs moved and the lumberyard restacked. I hauled off all the plastic reels. I would like to load up any steel lying around from the old days that is not usable. The old shotgun targets need to be taken apart, saving the chain, stands and selling the targets. The Stage Coach is in need of repair too. The floor in the supply room needs replacement and some work has to done on the office boardwalk. Please talk to Jonah if you can help out and he can set some dates.

Dirty Dog Dale, Dangerous Don and Handlebar Bob all came out along with Madam Ella Moon for a work party 3 weeks ago. We got the range grass cut and trimmed, wood burned and stacked, reels loaded up, stages set up, done some target repair and had a nice BBQ sausage lunch. Thanks for the help folks.

The club bought a NIB NM Ruger Vaquero fully engraved. Deep cut, very interesting style, absolutely gorgeous gun. We got a real bargain at \$875 delivered. I found it in Carson City NV. We will have to decide if it's going to be a raffle or Grand Prize for Comancheria Days 2008.
