Come join the Texican Rangers for COMANCHERIA DAYS from April 2 through April 5, 2009. The theme for the match will be "My Heroes Have Always Been Cowboys." Here at Stieler Ranch in the beautiful Texas hill country, we have a tradition of keeping Cowboy and Action in Cowboy Action Shooting, and we have 10 main match stages of both on Friday and Saturday. SASS rules apply.

Registration and side matches will begin at 1:00 P.M. on Thursday. Side matches will resume after the main match on Friday. Side matches will feature Fastest Rifle, Fastest Six Gun, Fastest Shotgun, Fastest Pocket Pistol and Fastest Derringer. We will have Sharpshooter Rifle (Pistol Caliber) and Long-Range Big Bore matches. We also offer the challenge of the Trail Walk, and the exciting **BLAZING SADDLES**.

The shooters meeting will be at 8:30 A.M. Friday and Saturday. This year we offer our new shooting category Cody-Dixon. In the main match stages, five rounds of big bore rifle, either single shot or lever action, are fired on long range targets. Cody-Dixon shooters are not eligible for first place overall because of the round count difference.

Please sign up for this event so we can have a count for the meat. After chuck, we will have cowboy entertainment so bring your guitar, fiddle, harmonica, etc., favorite cowboy poem or tall tale. **Remember, if you can't improve on a story, you have no business telling it!**

The Saturday night banquet and awards will be at the historic Nelson City Dance Hall & Saloon. This will be a barbecue dinner, and there will be a cash bar. There will be a costume contest during the shoot on Saturday and on Saturday night at the banquet. We will give away 5 guns in the shooters drawing, including a beautifully restored 1954 Winchester model 97. There will be a stretch raffle for a chance for more guns, a Dillon 650 press and other great prizes.

Sunday morning there will be Cowboy Church at 9:00 A.M. The shooters meeting will be at 9:45 and the master gunfighter competition at 10:00.

Camp sites are available at the ranch for \$10.00 per day. The camp is primitive, so bring your own water and electricity. No open fires please only Coleman stoves or B-B-Q pits. There are no dump stations, but there are chemical toilets on site. Campers may check in with Grouchy Spike after 1 P.M. on Wednesday, and he will show you where to set up.

There will be no fee for vendors.

Remember, your match fees include all side matches, main match stages, Friday night, Saturday Night banquet, shooters drawing, and Sunday activities.
