Terry' Texas Rangers *By Quintana*

At the June monthly shooting match of the Texican Rangers (the second oldest Cowboy Action Shooting Club in Texas) located on the Stieler Ranch near Fredericksburg, I dressed as a Terry's Ranger and wore six 1858 Remington .44 pistols and carried a double barrel muzzle loading 12 gauge shotgun. This caused quite a stir. SASS rules limit the number of pistols a CAS competitor can wear to two. Though our club is a SASS affiliated club, this was a local match and not considered a SASS sanctioned match, as in a SASS state match. So, I was able to live out my fantasy. It was a real "hoot". Fired both rounds from the shotgun, put it down and completed the remaining required shotgun targets with one pistol. Completed the scenario requirements for 10 rounds total from two pistols on steel pistol targets. Then, completed the standard 10 round rifle target engagement with two pistols, five rounds each. Over the course of six stages engaging 60 rifle targets ranging from 15 to 40 yards, I missed only one. I signed up the shooters' registration to participate in this match for a class titled "Terry's Texas Ranger", that never before existed. The scorekeeper even logged the competition class on the club published score sheet as TTR. Wow! I may have started something. What is so great about "Cowboy Action Shooting" is that it is so much fun. It combines an active shooting sport carried out with the highest degree of safety, with the opportunity to shoot with others with a common interest in historical perspective and Western tradition and shoot as fast or slow as you want. Like my wife says, she gets a kick out of the "bang" not the "ding".

Terry's Rangers were officially known as Eighth Texas Volunteer Cavalry Regiment. Terry was a wealthy east Texas plantation owner who organized and paid for the outfitting of this famous fighting unit. Most had their own horses. Many of the troops carried as many as, 8 pistols. Pommel holsters were common in these days. At their full strength this group comprised of approximately 1200 mounted Texans and were a mixed bag of frontiersmen, farm boys and wealthy planters. Most all were experienced horsemen and expert marksmen familiar with firearms. Unfortunately, Colonel Terry was one of the early casualties, however others followed in command.

Range Etiquette

Just a reminder – If you are coming to the range at times other than scheduled matches, please let Dusty Chambers know so he can let the land lord know of your impending arrival. This includes camping the night before the match. Also, if a gate is closed, please re-close it as you pass through. If there are several vehicles in line, insure that the last driver knows the gate needs to be closed. Closing gates that should be closed helps us stay on good terms with our land lord.
